Marshall Boutwell was born in North Carolina and grew up in a military family. In 1967, he volunteered for the U.S. Army. During his service in Vietnam, he was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross, Bronze Star Medal, Purple Heart, 12 Air Medals, and the Vietnamese Cross of Gallantry. He completed his military service in 1972 and then attended Campbell College.

Mr. Boutwell's career in business management includes positions with several companies in the financial services industry. He began his credit union career as President/CEO at Peach State Federal Credit Union in 1994, which has grown from \$14M to over \$916M in total assets during his tenure. The credit union serves more than 75,000 members with over 200 employees and 26 branches in Georgia and South Carolina.

Mr. Boutwell is a leader in the credit union movement and has served on numerous boards and committees. He has received the World Council of Credit Unions Distinguished Service Award, the Moses C. Davis Lifetime Achievement Award, the Knights Cross of the Order of Merit from the Republic of Poland and the Polish Credit Union Foundation "Feniks" Award for his support of Polish credit unions, and was inducted into the Credit Union House Hall of Leaders.
