Delores Glover serves as chair of the Supervisory Committee of Florida A&M University Federal Credit Union and has served on the committee for over 16 years. She served more than 18 years in the private sector in areas including management, customer service, human resources, accounting, and quality assurance for multiple corporations.

Ms. Glover recently returned to Florida A&M University (FAMU) after over 31 years with the University, of which she served in various areas. Ms. Glover created a new organizational approach to succession at FAMUCU and collaborated with the National Credit Union Administration, community leaders, and state and local government to develop an impactful partnership that strengthens opportunities for greater success.

Ms. Glover is the founder of the recently established Historically Black Credit Union Foundation and managed \$142M in Higher Education Emergency Relief Funding for the University, Title III, Part B and F. Ms. Glover assisted the University in acquiring \$126M in capital finance to build student dormitories. Ms. Glover recommended changes to the reauthorization of the Higher Education Act, which were approved and adopted by the Thurgood Marshall College Fund, United Negro College Fund, and the National Association of Equal Opportunity in Higher Education.
