Larry D. Sewell served as Commissioned Officer and Major in the U.S. Air Force, retiring after 17 years of service.

He retired from Together Credit Union (TCU) in April 2022, where he served as VP of Corporate Partnerships & Advocacy. He was active in the credit union movement for over 28 years, holding positions as the VP of Training & Development as well as the VP of Corporate Culture & Talent.

He is the Immediate Past Chairman of the African-American Credit Union Coalition Board of Directors. During his tenure as Chairman, AACUC received the Anchor Award from the NCUF. He served two years on the CUNA Advocacy Committee. A forward-thinking leader, he introduced diversity as a growth strategy in 1996 to TCU and the “Salad Bowl” diversity concept to credit unions. Mr. Sewell trained and coached the executive team and all staff for 20 consecutive years.
