The Honorable Rodney E. Hood is the Immediate Past Chair and currently serves as a Board Member for the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA).

Immediately prior to rejoining the NCUA Board in 2019 as Chairman, he served as a corporate responsibility manager for JPMorgan Chase, managing national partnerships with nonprofit organizations, financial regulators, and community stakeholders to promote financial inclusion and shared prosperity in underserved communities throughout the United States.

Mr. Hood served as a member of the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill Board of Visitors, the UNC School of Arts Board of Trustees, the Board of Trustees for the North Carolina Museum of Art, and the Board of Governors for the University of North Carolina College System.

Mr. Hood's professional awards include being named one of the "40 Young Leaders Under the Age of 40" by the Triangle Business Journal in Raleigh, North Carolina. He is also the first recipient of the "Dream Award," an award given by the Wells Fargo Housing Foundation to honor individuals who have exhibited an outstanding commitment to affordable housing.
