The Honorable Todd M. Harper joined the NCUA Board in April 2019, and was designated by President Joseph R. Biden, Jr., as the NCUA's twelfth Chairman in January 2021. He is the first member of the NCUA's staff to become an NCUA Board Member and Chairman, as well as the first openly gay man to lead a federal financial institutions regulatory agency. In working on credit union policy issues over two decades, Todd has remained laser focused on the statutory mission of credit unions to meet the credit and savings needs of their members, especially those of modest means, by prioritizing efforts to advance fairness within the financial system, improve economic equity, and close the racial wealth gap. Accordingly, Todd worked to more than double the funding available in 2023 for grants to low-income MDIs and to modify the NCUA's rules to maximize the benefits of the Treasury Department's Emergency Capital Investment Program. Because of Todd's leadership, the NCUA is also implementing new exam procedures in 2023 to address the unique challenges of MDI credit unions. Additionally, under Todd's leadership, the NCUA has nearly tripled the number of its fair lending examinations and reviews conducted annually, and the agency is now working on a rule to establish quality control standards for automated valuation models to ensure algorithms do not yield biased results and violate fair lending laws.
